



The earliest known printed use of the word *cocktail* was in *The Farmer's Cabinet* on April 28, 1803.

"Drank a glass of cocktail—excellent for the head...Call'd at the Doct's. found Burnham—he looked very wise—drank another glass of cocktail"

The earliest definition of *cocktail* was in the May 13, 1806, edition of the *Balance and Columbian Repository*, a publication in Hudson Magazine, New York, in which an answer was provided to the question, "What is a cocktail?".

It replied:

"Cocktail is a stimulating liquor composed of spirits of any kind, sugar, water, and bitters—it is vulgarly called a bittered sling and is supposed to be an excellent electioneering potion, inasmuch as it renders the heart stout and bold, at the same time that it fuddles the head. It is said, also to be of great use to a Democratic candidate: because a person, having swallowed a glass of it, is ready to swallow anything else"

Cosmopolitan	(Classic)	17.0

Classic supper cocktail with Cointreau, Absolut Kurrant Vodka then topped up with refreshing cranberry juice. French option is finished with French Sparkling wine.

Japanese Slipper	17.0
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Cointreau based cocktail with lemon juice to add that bitter, then starring sweet, melon-flavoured Midori, which means "green" in Japanese.

Martini	16.0
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The gin in martini should always be stirred, not shaken, so that the molecules lie sensuously one on top of the other, whilst the dry vermouth lines the glass. Your choice to garnish: a twist of lemon or an olive.

Mojito	16.0
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Cuba is the birthplace of the Mojito, dating back to the 16th Century. A muddle of lime, mint leaves and sugar syrup topped with Jamaican rum, soda and a sprig of mint

Pina Colada	16.0
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The Piña Colada was introduced in the 1950's at the Caribe Hilton's Beachcomber Bar in San Juan. This tropical cocktail contains coconut rum, pineapple juice and ample cream, all blended to give smooth, rich texture.

Singapore Sling	17.0
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One of the original scribbled recipes of this classic is still on display at the Raffles Hotel Museum, Singapore. Our version is a combination of gin, cointreau, cherry brandy, and sugar syrup, blended together with pineapple juice, creating a foamy top.



Mocktails

Athens cooler 9.0
A combination of apple and cranberry juices sweetened with honey and presented with maraschino cherries.

New York virgin 9.0
Light and refreshing, perfect for sweltering days, the New York Virgin includes fresh lime wedges, fresh mint leaves, sugar syrups and soda.

Shanghai summer nights 11.0
A gorgeous frozen mocktail contains orange and pineapple juice, fresh kiwi and strawberries.

St Petersburg Librarian 11.0
Citrus and berries make up this fruity drink, with fresh lime wedges, strawberries, cranberry juice, and soda to add some sparkle.

Virgin Mary 9.0
An old 'pick-me-up' favourite from Queen Mary based on tomato juice, Worcestershire sauce, Tabasco sauce, salt & pepper and finished with a celery stick. Be warned if you ask for extra 'hot and spicy'

A soft creamy mix with cointreau, kahlua, whole cream milk and a sprinkle of nutmeg.

Peppermint Prague 16.0
Best served after dinner, especially as a desert. It's mixed using crème de cacao, crème de menthe, fresh mint, thickened cream and chocolate wafer.

Seville's just deserts 19.0
'A sparkling apple pie in a glass', with Absolut vodka, vanilla Galliano, fresh muddled apples and a hint of cinnamon. Have your apple pie with or without cream.

Venizia Jaffa 19.0

Australian Wine History

Wine was brought to Australia by the early European settlers in the late 18th Century. Within 50 years the first wines of Australia were being produced and sent back to Europe. James Busby often referred to as the father of the Australian Wine Industry was a renowned viticulturist. During the early 1830's James Busby toured the wine regions of France and Spain collecting vine stock of many grape varieties. These original grape vine stocks were transferred to Australia and New Zealand by Busby.
