The Vintage Junior Golf Foundation Charter

1 – Purpose

The Vintage Golf Club and its' members established **The Vintage Junior Golf Foundation** in order to promote golf as a lifetime sport to young people within and surrounding our community. The foundation offers scholarships to young people who are not part of The Vintage community in order to assist them financially in pursuing their chosen sport. The foundation also has a junior program as a means of teaching young people the skills and knowledge needed to play the sport in a fun environment.

2 – Structure

The Vintage Junior Golf Foundation has been established as a **group** under The Vintage Golf Operations Pty Ltd who will provide insurance cover for the foundation's activities as covered by this charter.

3 - Objectives

The objectives of The Vintage Junior Golf Foundation are:

- a) To foster, develop and financially support junior golf in our local area.
- b) To provide scholarships to juniors who would not normally have the opportunity to become a member of The Vintage Golf Club. This is to be known as the "Junior Scholarship Program".
- c) To operate a junior golf development program that teaches junior golfers golf skills, etiquette, rules and safety. This is to be known as the "Junior Golf Development Program".
- d) To develop a golf program that will provide an influx of junior golfers into The Vintage so that the community has a good representation of people from all age groups.

4 – Committee

- a) A committee shall be elected on a yearly basis to oversee the running of the foundation.
- b) Elections shall be held at the beginning of each financial year (ie 1 July – 30 June).

- c) The Committee shall comprise but not be limited to the positions of Chairman, Deputy Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, The Vintage Golf Club representative and two Committee persons.
- d) Members of the Committee must be financial members or employees of The Vintage Golf Club.
- e) Only financial members of The Vintage Golf Club who have donated to The Junior Golf Foundation in the current or previous financial year, shall have voting rights to elect the Committee.
- f) The Committee shall meet on an as determined basis by the Committee but at least every six (6) months.
- g) The committee may amend the Charter but only after consulting with club members.

5 - Non Profit Status

The Vintage Junior Golf Foundation is to operate on a not for profit basis. It is to generate its' own income and account for its' own expenses and in no way is to have a financial impact on The Vintage Golf Operations Pty Ltd. The assets and income of The Vintage Junior Golf Foundation shall be applied solely in furtherance of its' above-mentioned objectives.

6 – Financial

- a) The treasurer shall be responsible for the keeping of the Foundation's accounts and shall report to the Committee at each meeting the financial position of the Foundation.
- b) A bank account is to be set up in the name of the Foundation which is required to have two signatories being the Chair and/or Deputy Chair and/or Treasurer for each cheque drawn.
- c) Funds shall be raised through Vintage Golf Club member's donations, sponsorships, Sunday morning lesson fees and various other methods as deemed appropriate by the Committee from time to time.

7 - Junior Scholarship Program

- a) One of the primary objectives of the foundation is to establish a Junior Scholarship Program which the committee will administer.
- b) The committee is to develop a policy for the administration and operation of the Junior Scholarship Program which should include, but not be limited to the nomination and selection process for scholarship recipients, financial support that the foundation is to provide to recipients, a mentoring program and golf development.

8 - Junior Golf Development Program

- a) The committee will facilitate a Junior Golf Development program in conjunction with the relevant Golfing Professional at The Vintage or other Golfing Professional as it considers appropriate.
- b) The committee is to develop a policy for the administration and operation of the Junior Golf Development program which should include, but not be limited to teaching juniors the skills, safety, etiquette and rules of golf.
